

Evergreen Park Horse Boarding and Riding Program

General Rules and Regulations

- No alcohol, and/or drugs are permitted within Evergreen Park or its facilities at any time
- No smoking is permitted within the Lewis Hawkes Pavilion or Drysdale Centre at any time
- Everyone must sign a waiver before riding with Evergreen Park facilities. Waivers are available at the Office.
- We are not responsible for any lost or stolen items
- Clean up after you AND your horse (droppings, hair, hoof clippings etc.)
- Box stalls are for the exclusive use of boarding horses ONLY
- Children under 16 years of age must be accompanied and actively supervised by an adult
- Dogs must be kept on a leash and outside of the riding area (with exception to working dogs)
- All fees will be paid prior to horse boarding services being provided – Evergreen Park reserves right to refuse service for unpaid invoices

Lewis Hawkes and Drysdale Riding Arenas

- Rentals are to be booked through Evergreen Park Sales Office
- Individuals wishing to undertake an activity that requires other riders to exit the arena need to rent the arena for their chosen activity, the riding arenas can be rented either by the hourly or daily rate
- Any activity involving cattle requires that the arena must be booked and rented, through the Evergreen Park Sales Office, either by the hourly or daily rate
- Rental of the arena requires minimum of 48 hours notice, as does cancellation of a previously booked rental (with exception for weather caused cancellation) – failure to cancel the event prior within required timelines will result in financial penalty
- Arena must be cleared when allocated time is over, and arena must be returned to its original condition, ie. free of garbage, jumps, etc.

Boarding Program

- Occupancy requirements are as follows: completed Application, if accepted, completed Horse Boarding Contract, First months boarding fees must be paid before the horse is moved onto the premises.
- No tying to the front of stalls
- Boarders are not to feed using the stable's feed unless authorized by Evergreen Park Management
- Any adjustments to horses care must first be reviewed and approved through the Barn Manager (ie; feed, blanketing etc.)
- Please check with Boarding Program employee before turning out any horse for whatever reason. There is a turn-out schedule in use
- If all boarding spaces are filled, a waiting list will be created, with stalls to be assigned on first come first serve basis as stalls become available
- Boarding horses terminating boarding contract are required to give a minimum seven (7) days prior notice, to avoid penalties.
- Boarding fees are due prior to or on the 5th day of each month, for that particular month. No exceptions to this payment timeline are permitted, without the written consent of Evergreen Park Management.
- Boarders must notify the barn Manager if they intend on removing their horse from the facility at any time.
